

Proper Exam Identification by State

State	Proper Identification
<p>Alabama</p>	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of current, official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). All identification must be current (not expired) and no birth certificates will be accepted. Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security card • Clinic card • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination. If your name is different, you MUST bring proof of your name change (a copy of an official document such as a marriage license or divorce decree) to the test center.</p>
<p>Colorado</p>	<p>Two (2) forms of current, not expired, signature-bearing identification. One MUST be a government-issued photo identification (for example: driver’s license). Please note: THE SIGNATURES ON THE TWO (2) IDs MUST MATCH. If you come to the test site without the proper ID, you will not be allowed to take the exam and you will lose your exam fee. Examples of proper identification include current, not expired:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security Card • Clinic Card • Credit Card • Library Card • State-issued identification card • Passport <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination. If your name is different, you will not be allowed to test.</p>

Northern California	<p>You are required to bring your original Social Security card and one form of legal photo identification that includes your signature when reporting to take the examination. This is a mandatory requirement issued by the California Department of Public Health (effective January 2002). Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Additionally, you must bring your signed CDPH 932 Form or CDPH 283B Form to testing every time you test.</p> <p>Examples of proper identification include</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Driver's license• DMV Identification card• Passport or Passport card• Permanent Resident Visa/Alien Registration card• U.S. Military ID card <p>The first and last names or suffix (ie Jr., II, III), on the current government photo identification, social security card, Nurse Assistant Certification (HS 283b), or CDPH Approval letter (932 Form) must be the same name used on the registration application to register for the examination. If you do not bring proper identification, or if your names do not match on all presented documents, you will not be allowed to test, and your examination fee will not be refunded. All documents presented at test site must be current, original, legible, and unaltered.</p>

State	Proper Identification
<p>Georgia</p>	<p>Candidates are required to bring two (2) forms of official signature-bearing identification to the test site, one of which must be a photo identification, and one of which must be a U.S. Government-issued Social Security Card (no letters from the Social Security Office will be accepted). Nurse Aide applicants who are in the armed services may use their current U.S. Military I.D. in place of a Social Security (SS) card. The test taker's SS number must be on the I.D. if used. Sponsor or Dependent Military I.D.s are NOT accepted in place of SS Card, but can be used as a second I.D. (one with photo) when presented with a valid SS card. All identification must be current (not expired) and no birth certificates will be accepted. If a candidate fails to present proper identification, he or she may not test. Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper photo identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • U.S. Government-issued driver's license • Georgia-issued voter I.D. card • Georgia Temporary driver's license • State-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card • Signed Photo High School I.D. (for high school students) • Signed Photo University I.D. (for university students) • U.S.-issued Photo Bearing Signed Military I.D. if not used in lieu of Social Security Card • Certificate of Naturalization <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination. If your name is different, you must contact customer service at least nine (9) calendar days prior to your scheduled examination. Be prepared to provide official government documentation of the name change to customer service.</p>

State	Proper Identification
<p>Maryland</p>	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security card • Clinic card • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination.</p>
<p>Mississippi</p>	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of current (not expired), signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security card • Clinic card • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination. If your name is different, you MUST bring proof of your name change (a copy of an official document such as a marriage license or divorce decree) to the test center.</p>

Nevada	<p>Two (2) forms of current, not expired, signature-bearing identification. One MUST be a government-issued photo identification (for example: driver's license). Please note: THE SIGNATURES ON THE TWO (2) IDs MUST MATCH. If you come to the test site without the proper ID, you will not be allowed to take the exam and you will lose your exam fee.</p> <p>Examples of proper identification include current, not expired:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Valid and unexpired Driver's License• State issued Identification Card• US Passport (Foreign Passports and Passport Cards are not acceptable)• Exception: A Foreign Passport that contains a US VISA is acceptable.• Military Identification <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination. If your name is different, you will not be allowed to test.</p>

<p>North Carolina (Nurse Aide)</p>	<p>Candidates are required to bring two (2) forms of current, not expired official U.S. government-issued signature-bearing identification (one of which must be photo-bearing) to the test site. Photocopies of identifications will not be accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One form of identification must be a U.S government-issued Social Security (SS) card, signed and not laminated. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Candidates who are in the armed services may use their current U.S. military identification in place of a SS card. The Candidate’s SS number must be on the identification, if used. Sponsor or dependent military identifications will not be accepted in place of a SS card. • A second form of identification must be any of the items listed below and must be photo-bearing. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Current, non-expired driver’s license <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Candidates who do not have their new license by exam day must bring their expired driver's license and their temporary permit. ○ Current, non-expired learner's permit ○ Military Identification <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Candidate’s SS number must be on the identification ▪ Sponsor military identification and a dependent military identification may be used when presented with a valid SS card. ○ State- or federal-issued identification card ○ Passport (US or foreign, current, non-expired) ○ Alien registration card ○ Employment authorization document (EAD) photo identification card (current, non-expired, federal-issued) <p>If a candidate fails to present proper identification, he or she will not be eligible to take the exam.</p> <p>The name listed on the identifications must be the same as the name used during the registration process. <p>North Carolina (Med Aide)</p>	<p>Candidates are required to bring two (2) forms of current, not expired official U.S. government-issued signature-bearing identification (one of which must be photo-bearing) to the test site. Photocopies of identifications will not be accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One form of identification must be a U.S government-issued Social Security (SS) card, signed and not laminated. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Candidates, who are in the armed services, may use their current U.S. military identification in place of a SS card. The Candidate’s SS number must be on the identification, if used. Sponsor or dependent military identifications will not be accepted in place of a SS card. • A second form of identification must be any of the items listed below and must be photo-bearing. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Current, non-expired driver’s license <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Candidates who do not have their new license by exam day must bring their expired driver's license and their temporary permit. ○ Current, non-expired learner's permit ○ Military Identification <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Candidate’s SS number must be on the identification. ▪ Sponsor military identification and a dependent military identification may be used when presented with a valid SS card. ○ State- or federal-issued identification card ○ Passport (US or foreign, current, non-expired) ○ Alien registration card ○ Employment authorization document (EAD) photo identification card (current, non-expired, federal-issued) <p>If a candidate fails to present proper identification, he or she will not be eligible to take the exam.</p> <p>The name listed on the identifications must be the same as the name used during the registration process. Pennsylvania	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Your Social Security card. • Clinic card • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination.</p>
Rhode Island	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). All identification must be current (not expired) and no birth certificates will be accepted. Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security card • Clinic card • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used on the application to register for the examination. South Carolina	<p>Candidates are required to bring two (2) forms of official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). If your name is different, you MUST bring proof of name change (a copy of an official document such as a marriage license or divorce decree) to the test center.</p>
Virginia	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). All identification must be current (not expired) and no birth certificates will be accepted. Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security card • Clinic card (example — Medicaid ID card) • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • Passport • Signed high school ID card — must have signature line • Signed university ID card — must have signature line <p>The first and last name on your identification must be the same as the first and last name you used on the application to register for the examination. If your first or last name is different, you MUST bring proof of your name change (a copy of an official document such as a marriage license or divorce decree) to the test center.</p>

State	Proper Identification
<p>Washington</p>	<p>You are required to bring two (2) forms of current, not expired, official, signature-bearing identification to the test site (one of which must be a photo identification). Photocopies of identification will NOT be accepted. Examples of proper identification include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driver’s license • Signature-bearing Social Security card • Clinic card • Credit card • Library card • State-issued identification card • School-issued identification card • Passport • Alien registration card • U.S. Passport Card accepted without signature. • Tribal ID (with photo and signature) <p>The name on your identification must be the same as the name you used to register for the examination, including suffixes. If your name has changed, you must log on to your account at least nine (9) calendar days prior to either scheduled exam, and follow the instructions you are given there. Be prepared to provide official government documentation of the name change.</p>
